By now, we will have had the bulk of the soft tissue healing. The gums should be looking healthy, and almost all of the signs of inflammation should have diminished. We use the full GBT protocol to remove all staining and start cleaning gently in the gums and around the problematic areas like the furcations and grooves. If any other vital dental work needs to be done, we will indicate when it can be done

This is the standard review date for any form of therapy. We will do a comprehensive check and look at your plaque levels and how well you have maintained your teeth. This appointment is also when we can frequently give a much more accurate prognosis on teeth in terms of surviving vs potential management otherwise. We will use the special plaque disclosing agent to show if or where the plaque is accumulating to give you the target areas to focus on in the future. Any more elective work can now be considered. The emphasis will be on improving your home care.

This appointment is where we determine your future treatment! Today we will do a comprehensive exam, full periodontal chart and compare it to your initial baseline measurements. We will also once again complete a full GBT protocol with emphasis on the plaque levels and how well you have been evolving your cleaning, particularly in between the teeth. The appointment is critical as this is where decisions are made with regards to your long term care. We will aim to move you as quickly as possible to the "Shared Care Protocol". The "Shared Care Protocol" consists of seeing your dentist and one of the clinicians at ProactivePerio on alternative visits. We usually start with your dentist in 3 months and the Proactive Perio team at the 6month timepoint.

## SUPPORTIVE PERIODONTAL THERAPY APPOINTMENTS

After your 6 month review, The Clinicians will discuss your requirement for ongoing supportive care. He may recommend that you return for supportive periodontal therapy (SPT) visits at intervals specific to your individual needs. The standard fees for SPT appointments are outlined below. This appointment is the same comprehensive appointment as at the 6months time point where we examine, chart and clean your teeth to make sure you maintain your gums and teeth and try to stop any further recurrence of disease or loss of bone and teeth.
